10TH ALL INDIA POLICE COMMANDO COMPETITION 2019 PUNE, MAHARASHTRA (11th DECEMBER 2019 TO 21st DECEMBER 2019)

JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

Introduction

1. Maharashtra Police is entrusted with the responsibility of hosting 10th All India Police Commando Competition for the year 2019-20. All India Police Commando Competition will be conducted in accordance with latest "Rules Regulations - All India Police Commando Competition" hand book issued by the Central Coordination Committee of All India Police Duty Meet, New Delhi.

Date

2. 10th All India Police Commando Competition for the year 2019 will be held at Wadachi Wadi, Pune, Maharashtra w.e.f. 11th Dec. 2019 to 21st Dec. 2019

Venue

3. The venue of this Commando Competition will be Wadachi Wadi, Pune, Maharashtra.

Climate

4. The climate during month of December will be cold with temp ranging from 12° C to 30° C.

Reporting

5. Competition is to be held w.e.f 14-20 December 2019. However, essential preliminary activities will commence w.e.f. 11 December 2019. Hence all teams are required to report at Pune, Maharashtra by 11 December 2019 (FN).

Reception & Transportation

- 6. All participating teams will intimate their travel plan, strength and mode of transport well in advance (30 days prior to commencement of the Commando Competition ie, 11 Nov. 2019) for arranging reception and necessary administrative arrangements for the teams to:
 - a) Control Room, 10th All India Police Commando Competition
 - b) Central Reception Centre at Urban Counter Terrorism Training Centre, SRPF Group No.1 Campus, Pune.

- 7. To facilitate the participating teams coming for 10th All India Police Commando Competition, a Central Reception Centre will be functional round the clock at Urban Counter Terrorism Training Centre, SRPF Group No.1 Campus, Pune. A Sub-Reception Centre will be functional during day hour at Pune Railway Station and Pune International Airport.
- 8. Transport will be provided by Maharashtra Police to the teams for arrival, departure and movement during the competition. Each team will be provided with one liaison officer.

Accommodation

9. Accommodation will be provided to the teams during the duration of competition. All participating teams are requested to clearly intimate the number of participants in our e-mail ID (aipcc.pune@gmail.com) so that suitable lodging arrangements etc. can be made accordingly.

Messing

10. All the teams must bring their own Mess detachment including, Mess supervisor, cooks, sweeper, mess boy, utensils, gas burner and other required items for functioning of their respective Messes. Teams can purchase grocery items, fresh vegetables, condiments & milk from the nearby market. Gas Agency will be made available to purchase filled gas cylinders. Filled gas cylinder will be provided on Security Deposit of Rs. 3500/- at Gas Agency. For better arrangement and smooth functioning of Mess, team should send their mess detachment three days prior to the arrival of their teams.

Clothing & Bedding

11. It is cold during the month of Dec.19, hence every team member must carry adequate warm clothes (including uniform), winter bedding and mosquito net for a comfortable stay.

Security Money & Entry Fee

12. On arrival at Pune, each team will have to deposit Rs. 1000/- (One Thousand rupees only) as Security Money. Entry Fee for the Competition will be Rs. 100/- for each participant including reserves/Team Manager/Coaches and other members. The amount of Entry fee should be remitted along with entry forms through Bank Draft in favour "10TH ALL INDIA COMMANDO COMPETITION, A/c No 38799644773 payable at State Bank of India, Pulgate, Pune, IFS Code – SBIN0008044

Entry Form

13. The entry form (format attached as Appendix A) must be duly signed by an officer / not below the rank of Commandant/Superintendent of Police to be sent to Organising

Secy, 10th AIPCC, Pune before 11 Nov. 19. Each Entry form should not contain more than 24 names. Separate entry form should be used to add the details of additional personnel. The entry form should have a certificate at the bottom of it stating that :-

- "All the participants are physically and mentally fit to participate in 10th All India Police Commando Competition and that during the competition, if any participant sustains any injury/grievously hurt, organizer (Maharashtra Police) will not be responsible for it".
- 14. The teams are required to submit the photocopy of the same entry form by post or E-mail to the organiser. Original copy of the entry form should be handed over to the organisers on arrival at the venue.

Eligibility Criteria

15. Every participant, participating in 10th All India Police Commando Competition, must have completed a minimum of Three months of continuous service in Police Organisation/Central Armed Police Force. An individual is permitted to participate only thrice in a Commando Competition. A certificate should be appended to that effect at the bottom of the entry form, duly signed by an officer not below the rank of Commandant/Superintendent of Police, stating that:- (The entry forms should not contain more names than the limit as laid down).

Recce & Familiarization by Team Representatives

16. All teams can send their respective recce and familiarization representatives comprising of 1-2 Officers/Sub-ordinate Officers and 2-3 HCs/Constables between 01 - 15 Nov. 19 at Urban Counter Terrorism Training Centre, SRPF Group No.1 Campus, Pune. No familiarization visits will be accepted after 15 Nov. 19. Google image of general area for STO 1 and blueprint of building for STO 2 are attached as Sketch P & Q respectively.

Return Air/Rail Reservation

17. Teams can move back on 22 Dec. 19 after termination of 10th All India Police Commando Competition, and can plan their advance Air/Rail reservations accordingly.

Conduct

18. The 10th All India Police Commando Competition will be conducted as per the instructions/guidelines given in the latest "Rules and Regulations - All India Police Commando Competition" handbook issued by Central Coordination Committee of All India Police Duty Meet.

Clinic Meeting

19. A clinic meeting of the Team Managers, Team Captains and Coaches with respective conducting technical officials will be held at Pune at 17.00 hrs. on 12 Dec. 19. It is compulsory for all the participating Team Managers, Team Captains and Coaches to attend the clinic meeting.

Draw of Lots

20. Draw of lots will be conducted on 12 Dec. 19 during clinic meeting in the presence of all Team Managers, Team Captains and Coaches to decide the sequence and timing of the teams.

Uniform

21. All the members of the participating teams are requested to wear prescribed Commando Uniform of their respective organisations during the competition and also during the Opening & Closing ceremonies.

Opening & Closing Ceremonies

22. The Opening ceremony will be held on 14 Dec. 19 and Closing Ceremony will be held on 21 Dec. 19. All teams should bring their respective State Police/Central Armed Police Force/Union Territories Police flags of the following specification.

(a) Flag for Hoisting - 6' X.4' (02 Nos)

(b) Flag for March Past - 3' X 2' (02 Nos)

Discipline

23. A high standard of discipline is expected from all ranks of the participating teams. The team manager/captain will be personally responsible for the discipline of the team during competition and stay.

Health Card or Medical Fitness Certificate

24. All participants are required to bring their Health Card/Medical Fitness Certificate

issued by their Medical officer/doctor within two months prior to the conduct of 10th All India Police Commando Competition. No participant will be allowed to participate in the competition without latest Health Card/Medical Fitness Certificate.

Identity Card

25. All participants are required to bring their Identity Card issued by their respective State Police/CAPF. No participant will be allowed to participate in the competition without valid Departmental Identity Card.

Commando Identity Card

26. The team managers of the participating teams should deposit two recent passport size photographs in uniform of each participant and official duly attested for the purpose of preparing Commando Identity Cards on arrival.

Security

27. In order to ensure security, all the officials and members of the participating teams are required to carry their Identity Cards during stay in Pune.

Medical Assistance

28. Medical assistance will be provided during the competition period to all members of the participating teams.

- 29. The participating teams will have to submit the details of their members of the teams to the organizer in the format of various forms as follow.
 - (a) Entry Form (attached as Appendix A).
 - (b) Participant Details (attached as Appendix B).
 - (c) Arrival Details (attached as Appendix C).
 - (d) Departure Details (attached as Appendix D).

Weapons, Equipments, Ammunition & Store

30. Teams will bring all Weapons, Equipments, Ammunition, stores and ensure its security.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR

STAND ALONE SNIPER FIRING COMPETITION

General

1. All India Police Stand alone Sniper Firing Competition (AIPSFC) for all State Police & CAPF will be conducted by Maharashtra Police at Wadachi Wadi, Pune, Maharashtra. The competition will be conducted under the aegis of Maharashtra Police on 20 Dec.2019 during the course of AIPCC. The score of Sniper Rifle firing competition will not be included in the over all score of AIPCC.

Aim

2. To test the sniper firing ability of State Police and CAPF Sniper dets.

Participation

3. A total of two detachments (2x2) will participate in the competition for respective State Police/ CAPF. All participating organizations will forward the name of Sniper dets to Pune by the 11 Nov.2019. Sniper detachment will be over and above the members of AIPCC.

Conduct

4. Rules:

- a) Only 01 detachment of competitors from participating organization will participate in each firing detail according to their respective lots.
- b) All sniper detachments are allowed to use their service Sniper rifle along with ammunition for participating in the competition. No Sniper rifle and ammunition shall be provided by the host.
- c) Usage of respective day sight is only permitted.
- d) There shall be no fix ranges for firing practices. The firing range will be between 300 to 500 meters.
- e) Post firing respective fired targets will be shown to the firers. These targets and result sheet shall be signed by the firers and the range officer.

- f) All firers will keep their loaded magazine for check before going to their respective firing line.
- g) No points will be given for any misfire round and there will be no allowances for any other stoppages or malfunctions. All misfired rounds will be collected by the range officer after each detail firing. Another round will be allowed to firer in case of misfire with same time allowance.
- h) In case of a hit on the border line of two score areas of target, the firer gets the advantage and the higher score in between of the two shall be counted.
- i) For the ruby target any hit or touch on border line of minus score area of target will consider for minus marking.
- j) No outside member will be allowed to coach the firer during any point of practices. No unauthorized personnel will enter the firing range area. If any personnel of any organization is found using unfair means the concern group will be penalized amounting to the disqualification from the competition.
- k) The unexpended ammunition with the magazine shall be left at the respective firing points by the competitors.
- 1) In case of tie for the first / second position a separate match shall be conducted as decided by the Jury.
- m) Practices of sniper will be conducted during day time no changes in the nominal role will be entertained ones it is submitted to Maharashtra Police.
- **5.** <u>Match fixture</u>: This will be decided later as per response received form States / CAPF
- **6.** <u>Targets</u>: Types of targets as attached as Appx. 'A' (to be catered by respective participating teams)

7. Jury of appeal /organizing committee

The executive committee is empowered to use its discretion in any matter not covered by the rules.

- **8.** <u>Protest</u>: Protests if any should be lodged within 15 Minutes of termination of the particular firing details in writing that should be addressed to the chairman of the Jury of appeal along with Rs.1000/- as non refundable protest fee.
- **9. Prizes**: Trophy for Best Sniper dets will be awarded to the adjudged the best Sniper det as well as the trophy of best team will be awarded.
- **10.** <u>Dress and Equipments</u>: The participants will be dress in their respective uniforms or Dangree. They shall be in possession of the following.
 - a) Identity Card
 - b) Own Weapon & Ammunition
 - c) Cleaning Kit

11. Penalty and Disqualification:

following act may attract penalty / disqualification -

- a) Misbehavior / Argument with the conducting staff on the day of competition
- b) Wearing of improper / unauthorized dress
- c) Losing any contour / weapon
- d) Time restriction will be given for all firing practices. If competitor fire after given time 05 marks will be deducted from his total earning points. There after if competitor again fires after the stipulated time than the competitor will be disqualified for the competition.
- e) Unauthorized member of any organization found in the firing areas during the restricted hours of the competition.

Identity of Participants:

- 12. All participants will produce their respective ID cards at firing range.
- 13. <u>Documents</u>: The following documents are required to be produced by the firer on firing range for verification:
 - a) Weapon (weapon should be remain same for each firing practice)
 - b) Weapon inspection certificate
 - c) Original nominal roll countersigned by the superior officer (Entry form)
- 14. <u>Security</u>: The team captain of respective organization will be responsible for the following:
 - a) Security of weapons / Ammunition including carriage to and from ranges
 - b) Discipline including range discipline of all team members
- 15. Officials: All participating organizations will detail one officer as a representative of their respective organizations at a day of competition. The name of that official should be forwarded to Maharashtra Police.
- 16. <u>Ammunition</u>: Ammunition shall be catered by the participating organizations for their respective Sniper dets. Ammunition will check by the range officer on the time of fire.
- 17. **Result**: The executive committee will compile and forward the result to Maharashtra Police.
