(FROM 03 TO 09 FEBRUARY, 2020)

JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

1. GENERAL

The Central Academy for Police Training (CAPT), BPR&D, Bhopal has been assigned with the responsibility to conduct the **12th All India Police Badminton Championship-2019**. The Championship will be held at **Sports Complex, CAPT, Bhopal w.e.f. 03 to 09 February, 2020**, for Gazetted Officers (GOs) and Non Gazetted Officers (NGOs) under the aegis of All India Police Sports Control Board (AIPSCB). Only those personnel who have been enlisted in their respective CAPFs / Police Organization for a continuous period of not less than three months before the date of commencement of the Championship are eligible to participate. The championship will be conducted in accordance with the Rules & Regulations laid down by the Badminton Association of India as amended from time to time and the conditions prescribed in the General Rules of the All India Police Sports Control Board, New Delhi.

2. VENUE

Sports Complex, CAPT, Bhopal is located in the premises of the Central Academy for Police Training, Bhopal. It is situated at about 22 Kms from Bhopal Railway Station, 25 km from ISBT and 25 km from Raja Bhoj Airport, Bhopal. The Stadium is having wooden courts with lighting facility. It is likely that synthetic turf will be laid well before the Championship. Matches will be played throughout the day as per schedule and if required at night as well.

3. CLIMATE

Weather at Bhopal during the month of January is cold and pleasant with temperature ranging from 13° to 25° C. Therefore, the participants are advised to bring appropriate clothing, bedding and mosquito net.

4. RECEPTION

The Reception of the participating teams will be made at Airport and Railway Stations as per the teams' arrival schedule. Appropriate Reception Team will be placed at above mentioned places for the participants. It is requested to intimate the date & mode of travel, well in advance for making necessary arrangements for reception,

accommodation & conveyance. A Liaison Officer (LO) will be provided to the participating teams for guiding them during the Championship. Participants are also requested to get their return journey reservation done in advance so as to avoid any inconvenience.

5. **TRANSPORT**

Transportation from Railway station, ISBT and Airport to CAPT will be provided.

6. **BOARDING & LODGING**

Accommodation for the teams shall be provided from **01 February, 2020** onwards. The details of participants should be sent to the Organizing Secretary by 25 January, 2020 for making necessary arrangements. Accommodation for NGOs will be provided in PF Barracks, whereas SOs and GOs will be accommodated in Guest House / Hostels /Officers' Mess in the CAPT campus. Food to the participants will be provided on payment basis.

7. **MEDICAL FACILITIES**

The Academy is having a 10 bedded hospital within the campus. Medical facilities will be provided at the place of accommodation as well as Games Venue round the clock as per the requirement.

8. **ENTRIES**

The participating teams are required to submit their entries online at www.aipscb.com, No team will be entertained if they have not made their entries online. The last date of making the entries is 25 January 2020. No entries shall be entertained after 25 January 2020. Entry fee **will be Rs. 300/-** per team for team event, **Rs.100/-** per participants for the open singles / veteran singles and **Rs.100/-** per pair for open doubles / veteran doubles / mixed doubles including Team Manager, Reserve, Coaches, Doctors and Adm. Staff etc. All the teams are requested to remit the entry fee through **online transfer** in favour of **“ORGANIZING SECRETARY 12TH AIPBC-2019”** payable at State Bank of India, ANAND Nagar Branch, Bhopal. **Account NO.39041268316 & IFSC Code: SBIN0016153** on or before the 25 January 2020. Other form of money transfer, such as BHIM, RTGES, etc, is also accepted. **CASH WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS ENTRY FEE** The fees for lodging protest of any kind shall be Rs. 1000 /- which organizers hall retain with them. Any protest shall be addressed to the Org. Secretary in writing within one hour after completion of the match who shall forward the same to Jury of Honour and Appeal.

9. MANAGERS' MEETING

A meeting of Team Managers / Coaches will be held on 02 February, 2020 at 02.00 PM at **Conference Hall Academic Block**, CAPT Bhopal for briefing on the Championship. It will be followed by Official Clinic. Lot of Draw of the matches will also be drawn during the meeting in presence of the observers of All India Police Sports Control Board. The copy of program will be handed over to the teams just after the draw is over.

10. REHEARSAL FOR OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONY

Rehearsal of march-past for opening and closing ceremony will be held at **CAPT Bhopal**. The date and time for rehearsal will be intimated to the teams on arrival.

11. OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONY

Opening Ceremony will be held on 03 February, 2020 and closing ceremony will be held on 09 February, 2020. The Dress code for both the ceremonies will be Track Suit (of their respective Police organization). All the participating teams should bring **two flags of size 4 feet x 6 feet and 3 feet x 2 feet** of their respective organization, which would be required for hoisting and March pasts / Line up respectively during the Game.

12. PRACTICE

The Badminton Court at Sport complex, CAPT Bhopal, where the competition is being held, will be made available to the participants only one day before commencement of the competition on first come first serve basis. The practice time will be decided by the Organizing Secretary.

13. CONDUCT OF THE GAMES

The 12th All India Police Badminton Championship 2019 shall be conducted as per the terms and conditions laid down by the Badminton Association of India, All India Police Sports Control Board and the decisions taken in the Manager meeting.

14. BADMINTON RACKET AND OTHER EQUIPMENTS

All teams / participants are requested to bring their own Badminton Racket and other equipments related to Badminton Sports pertaining to their personal use.

15. SECURITY

All the participating Officers / players including Team Manager, Reserve, Coaches, Doctors and Adm. Staff etc. are required to always wear the identity card issued by the academy.

16. DOPING TEST

NADA and WADA Anti Doping Norms will be applicable during the Championship. A random Doping Test will be conducted during the Championship and if any competitor is found in possession / using drugs and narcotics to improve his / her performance, the individual along with the team will be disqualified from the Championship. The participants are therefore, warned against possession / use of any banned substances listed under NADA / WADA for performance enhancement.

17. GIST OF RULES & REGULATIONS

12th All India Police Badminton Championship 2019 will be governed by the rules prescribed by the Badminton Association of India and as per instructions issued by All India Police Sports Control Board. The salient features of the rules & regulations are as under:-

- A. The Championship will comprise the following events :-
 - i. **Team Event – Open to all ranks (both GOs & NGOs)**
 - 1. There will be 2 singles & 1 double match. The participant shall be from the same organization.
 - 2. All the teams would be divided in eight pools
 - 3. League matches will be played on pool basis
 - 4. The top most team of each pool would qualify for the Quarter Finals.
 - ii. **Open Category – Open to all ranks (both GOs & NGOs)**
 - 1. Men's singles
 - 2. Men's doubles
 - 3. Ladies singles
 - 4. Ladies doubles
 - 5. Mixed doubles
 - iii. **Veteran Category Only 45+ - Open to all ranks (both GOs & NGOs)**
 - 1. Men's singles

2. Men's doubles
3. Ladies singles
4. Ladies doubles
5. Mixed doubles

iv. Gazetted Officers only – Open Category

- a. Men's singles
- b. Men's doubles
- c. Mixed doubles

v. Gazetted Officers only – Veteran Category 45+

- a. Men's singles
- b. Men's doubles
- c. Mixed doubles

- B. For constituting a team and doubles, players should be from the same organization.
- C. Separate singles and doubles matches will be organized for serving lady officers provided there are lady participants from at least 10 different police organizations.
- D. The participating Police organizations must have a team comprising minimum of two players to be eligible to take part in the Championship. **The total strength of the participating team should not exceed 12 members .**
- E. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel the event, if the number of teams for any event is less than 10 as per rules of AIPSCB. In the event of less than 10 teams, medals / trophies will not be given and the competition will be treated as Show Match only.
- F. The team event will comprise of two singles and one doubles with the doubles played between two single matches.
- G. All matches will be decided on the basis of the best of 3 games as per the rules of BAI.
- H. The decision of the Organizing Committee will be final regarding all matters pertaining to the Championship & such decision will be binding on all the participants.
- I. Only serving Police Officers of the rank of Dy. SP/equivalent rank and above (GOs) and NGOs below the level of Dy.SP/equivalent rank who have been enlisted in their respective Police organizations for a continuous period of not

less than three months before the date of commencement of the Championship, are eligible to participate in the Championship.

- J. Any other instruction / guidelines found suitable by the Organizing Committee for smooth conduct of the Championship as per stipulated rules will be issued in due course.

18. CO-ORDINATION / CORRESPONDENCE
